

# CURRENT PRIESTS AND SEMINARIANS




Estimated Number of Diocesan Priests Available for Assignment

### DIOCESAN POPULATION TREND











PARISH MEMBERS & MASS ATTENDANCE












#### Baptisms vs Deaths—Line of Equal




